Key skills:

Complementary and analogous colours



In this unit, the children will explore the use of complementary and analogous colours within their art work. **Complementary** colours are colours that are opposite each other on the colour wheel. **Analogous** colours are colours that are next to each other on the colour wheel.

Combine visual and tactile qualities

Additionally, the children will be developing their use of collage and combining materials of differing texture to create a final collage in the style of Este MacLeod. They will draw on their knowledge of colour to assist them in this.



Key questions

Who is Este MacLeod?

Through her artwork Este MacLeod reflects on life. She is primarily a colourist painter focusing on household objects, plants and nature in still life and landscape paintings. She uses methods such as writing a quote and using lines, colours, layers of paint and a variety of materials to turn it into a picture.

What is collage?

It is an art form which is made up of overlapping pieces of material, such as photographs, fabric, coloured and textured paper and other types of mixed media.

Does art always have to be paintings?

The impact of Este MacLeod's artwork demonstrates that art can be in many forms, including using mixed media and a range of fabrics and materials.
