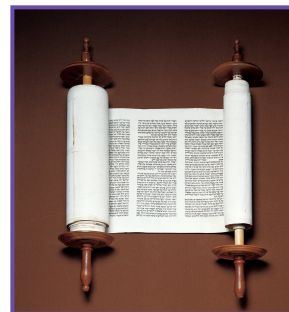

The Torah

The Torah is a very special book for Jewish people because it teaches them how to live good and kind lives. It is full of stories and lessons that help people understand how to care for others, be honest, and make good choices. It also tells the story of important people, like Moses, who listened to God and helped others.

Star Vocabulary

Judaism	The name of the religion that Jewish people follow and believe in.
Community	A group of people who live or work together in the same area, or who have something important in common.
Torah	A very important text for Jewish people which refers to the first five books of the Jewish Bible, or Books of Moses.
Synagogue	A building where Jewish people go to worship.
Ritual	A set of actions people do, usually at a set time or for a certain reason.
Shabbat	The Jewish day of rest. This is the most important day in the week which begins on Friday and ends Saturday at sundown.
Rabbi	A Jewish religious leader who is usually in charge of a synagogue.

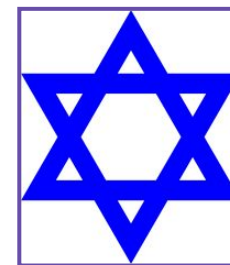
