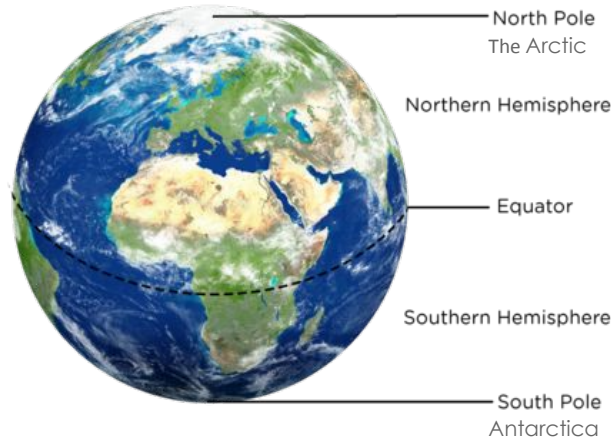

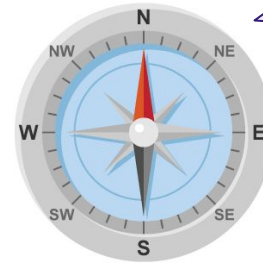


People that live near the north pole are called Inuits.

What would it be like to live in a polar region?



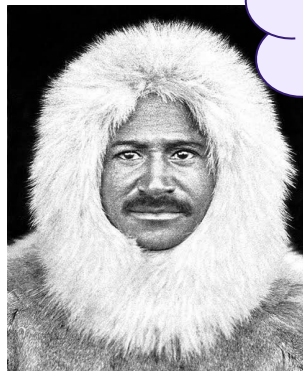
A compass can help us navigate when we are going on an expedition. We need to **orientate** the map and then use the directions to help guide us.



The Halley Research Station allows scientists to live in Antarctica for short periods of time.



Sisimiut is a city in Greenland, inside the Arctic Circle. Over 5000 people live in this city. Greenland is a Danish territory in the continent of North America.

Roald Amundsen was the first person to reach the South Pole in 1911!
