### Key Learning:

Muslims believe that there is only one God called Allah. They believe Allah is the only ruler of the universe. The word 'Islam' means submission and obedience to Allah.

Muslims believe Allah created the world, just as he wanted it to be, in 'harmony'. They believe Allah has given them the responsibility to take care of the world for their future generations so that Allah's creation will be everlasting.
