Appendix 1

We made income of £22,020. Costs associated with raising these funds were £6,779.

Donations to the school this year totaled £8,930 including:

- £5,000 for the KS2 Trim Trail
- £2,500 for the EYFS Outdoor Area
- £732 for the Year 6 Leavers Celebration
- £472 for Christmas Books
- £226 for Year 2 School ties

The Christmas and Summer Fairs made profits of £4,439 and £4,023 respectively. Movie Night was a new event making £223 profit. The school disco, which was held at the end of the school year made £449 profit. Our popular break the rules day made £707. The Christmas Cards designed by the children continues to be a good money maker with a profit of £379. Cake and Uniform Sales raised a profit of £879 with the addition of the uniform rail in the foyer creating a lot more income from uniform. Finally, the Quiz Night and Spring Bingo generated £722 and £137. The income for both the Christmas Fair and Quiz Night were doubled due to matched funding.

Overall, for the year there has been a profit of £6,025.

The closing cash balance on 31st August 2024 was £9,005.53.
