Key Learning:

It is the intention of this unit to explore how Christians believe Jesus was a friend and Saviour ('rescuer'), to people he met, who often included the poor and friendless.

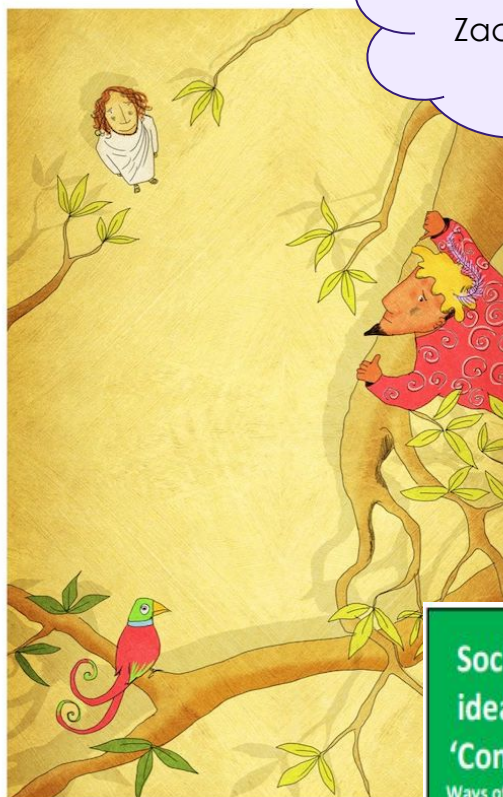
Christians believe that meeting Jesus changed people's lives ('rescued' them).

Christians believe that Jesus was born at Christmas. At Easter, Christians believe that Jesus died and was resurrected on Easter Sunday.

Christians believe That Jesus is God 'in human form'

Christians believe that Jesus offers forgiveness as part of his rescue.

The Bible tells a story of Jesus meeting a man called Zacchaeus who was up a tree!

Palm Sunday - Jesus returned to Jerusalem

Maundy Thursday - Jesus had 'The Last Supper' with his Disciples.

Good Friday - Jesus died

Easter Sunday - Jesus was resurrected.
