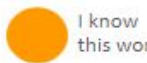

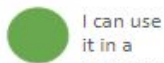

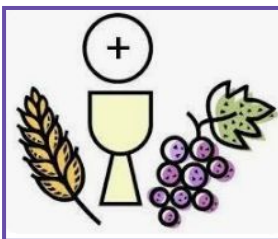

Key Knowledge:

That most Christians believe that:

- the Church is part of God's Kingdom
- the Holy Spirit is alive and active in the world, as well as in the hearts of individuals and in the Church
- Pentecost is the birth-day of the Church
- baptism, sharing communion, worship and service are signs of membership of the Church
- the Church has spread throughout the world and is enormously diverse, expressing the inclusivity of Jesus' message
