Key Questions that we will be exploring:

1. Why is Allah so important to Muslims and how does this affect how Muslims might live?
2. How might prayer (salah) and Hadith affect the lives of many Muslims? How do they lead to a good life?
3. How might the belief in the two angels who record a person's good and bad deeds would affect how many Muslims lead their lives?
4. What might motivate a Muslim to pray/ give alms/ fast and what effect would this have on their lives – and on the Muslim community?
5. What is Hajj and why might many Muslims want to be part of an ummah?
6. What helps Muslims to have a good life?

Key information

Islam is a monotheistic religion and Allah is eternal, omniscient, and omnipotent. A believer can approach Allah by praying, and by reciting the Qur'an. Hadith (sayings of the Prophet, pbuh) guide the way many Muslims live. The pillars (or duties) of Islam can help many Muslims to have a good life. We will explore the purpose of the Two Angels, which are said to sit on either shoulder of a Muslim person and times of celebrations also help Muslims to live a good life (Eid-ul-Fitr & Eid-ul-Adha).
