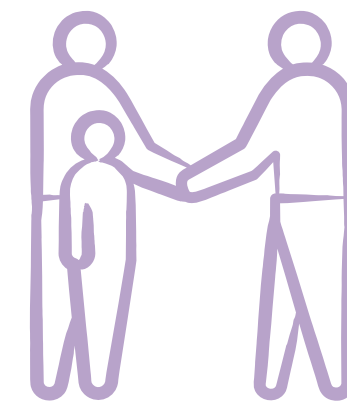




# Leading Parent Partnership Award - LPPA

8. Produces and implements parent-friendly policies to establish effective home school-links and improve children's attendance, punctuality, behaviour and progress.

10. Summarises its achievements against the LPPA and outlines future plans.
