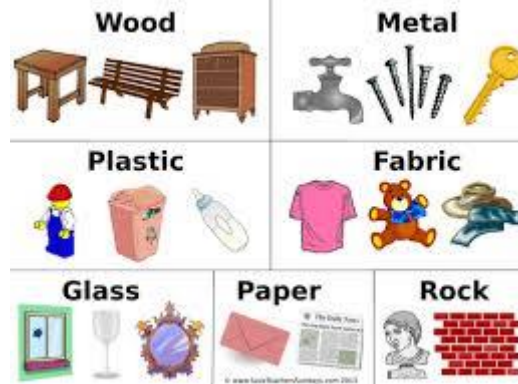

Celebrating Differences

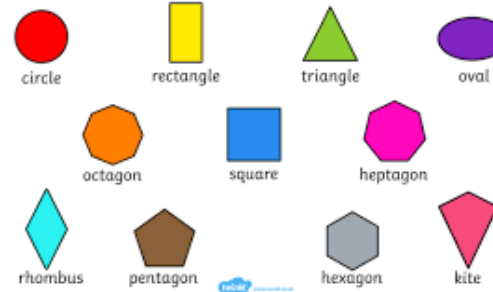
- Children will find differences between people in their class
