## MATHS Fractions and multiplication

- Use short division to divide up to 4-digit numbers
- Divide with remainders and choose efficient strategies
- Solve problems involving multiplication and division
- Multiply fractions by whole numbers
- Find fractions of amounts and quantities
- Use fractions as operators
