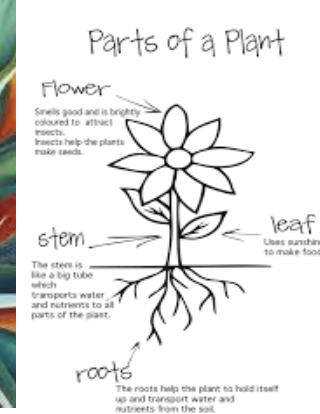
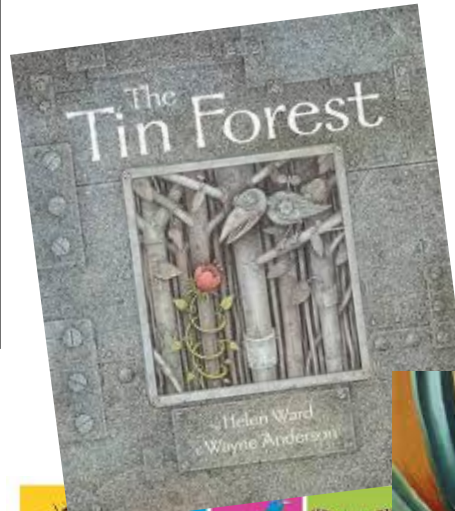
- To explore the part that flowers play in the life cycle of flowering, including pollination, seed formation and seed dispersal
