MATHS

Decimals

- Identify tenths and hundredths are fractions and decimals.
- To divide a 1- and 2-digit number by 10 and 100.
- To recognise and write decimal equivalents to $1/4$, $1/2$, $3/4$
- To round decimals with 1 decimal place to the nearest whole number
- To compare numbers with the same number of decimal places up to 2 decimal places

- Solve simple measure and money problems involving fractions and decimal to two decimal places (fractions)
- Write money using decimals. Convert between pounds and pence. Compare amounts of money.
