Geographical skills and field work

- Contours, hills, scale, symbols

MATHS

- Draw 2-D shapes and make 3-D shapes using modelling materials
- Recognise angles as a property of shape or a description of a turn.
- Measure the perimeter of simple 2-D shapes.
- Tell and write the time from an analogue clock, including using Roman numerals from I to XII, and 12-hour and 24-hour clocks
- Estimate and read time with increasing accuracy to the nearest minute; record and compare time in terms of seconds, minutes and hours
- Know the number of seconds in a minute and the number of days in each month, year and leap year
