How To Find Gold

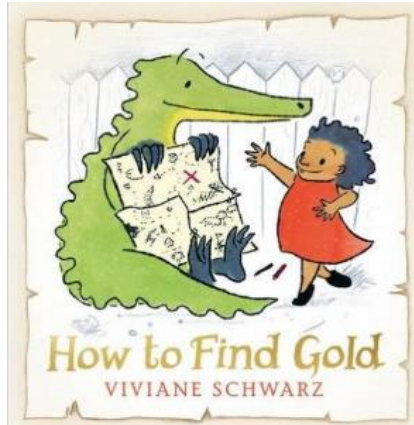
- Form letters
