COMMUNICATION & LANGUAGE

- Retell a story, some as exact repetition and some in their own words.
- Learn new vocabulary linked to our topic (eg. hero, villain)
- Articulate their ideas and thoughts in well-formed sentences.
- Listens to and learns rhymes and songs.

EXPRESSIVE ARTS & DESIGN

- To engage in role play and recreate roles
- Create art in the style of famous artist Giuseppe
- Experiment to create different textures and effects e.g. potato printing
- Creating and exploring different patterns
- Exploring colour mixing
- Explore, use and refine a variety of artistic effects to express their ideas and feelings
- Sing in a group, increasingly Matching the pitch and following the melody
- Explore and engage in music making and dance performing in groups
