Round decimals with 2 decimal places to the nearest whole number and to 1 decimal place

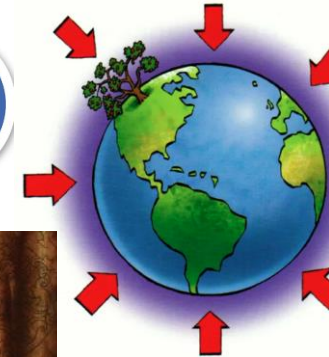
Read, write, order and compare numbers with up to 3 decimal places

HISTORY Tudors

- Examine different aspects of history eg social, cultural, political and religious
- Explore trends, looking at continuity/change and similarity /difference/significance
- Understand how knowledge of the past is constructed from a range of sources

SCIENCE Forces

Explain that unsupported objects fall towards the Earth because of the force of gravity acting between the Earth and the falling object
