MUSIC

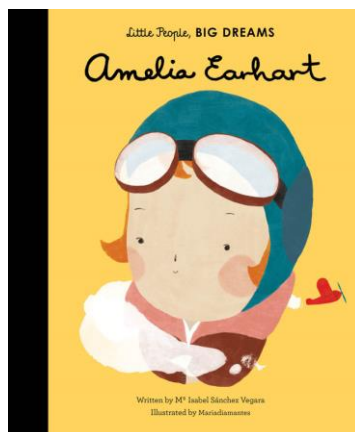
Friendship Song

How has air travel changed over time?

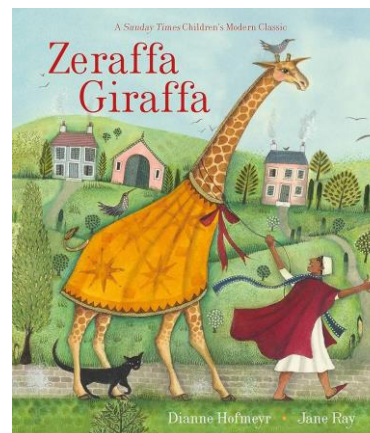
- How aeroplanes have changed and why
