Technology Around Us

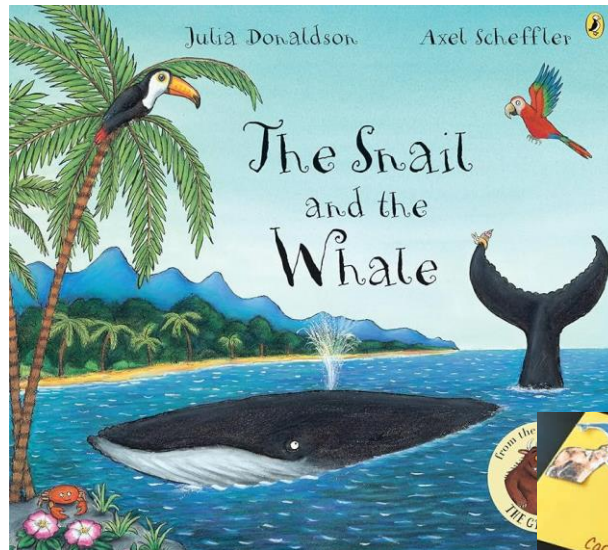
- Recognise uses for technology at home and school
